SUBJECT: AR 95-1 Request for Waiver to Altitude Chamber Requirements

1. Your request at enclosure 1, dated 1 Oct 03, requesting an operational waiver for selected aviation personnel in support of Operation Enduring Freedom and Iraqi Freedom is approved.
2. Aviators affected by this operational waiver will be examined by a Flight Surgeon prior to the expiration of their altitude chamber currency to ensure there are no health related issues that preclude them from flying with an expired altitude chamber ticket.
3. This limited waiver is LAW the proposed change to FM 3-04.301 which changes altitude chamber currency requirements from three to five years.
