MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

**SUBJECT:** SOP for the Flight Surgeon's Aircraft Investigation Kit

**APPLICABILITY:** Flight Surgeons and Aviation Physician Assistants assigned or attached to the XX Aviation Brigade.

**REFERENCE:** Fort Rucker Aircraft Investigation Handbook

1. The Squadron Flight Surgeon has overall responsibility for the serviceability and inventory of the Aircraft Investigation Crash Kit (AICK).
2. The AICK is contained in a metal ammo can and is set up as a field expedient means for the Flight Surgeon or Aviation Physician Assistant to conduct an aircraft accident investigation. It is NOT intended that the AICK is the only tool for an accident investigation but it is an aid to the FS or APA.
3. The Flight Surgeon or Aviation Physician Assistant that is assuming the duties for aircraft accident investigation will sign DA Form 2062 assuming responsibility for serviceability and accountability of all items in the kit.
4. The primary AICK is located with the on-call Flight Surgeon or Aviation Physician Assistant. The secondary AICK will remain in the brigade's clinic.
5. When the squadron does not have aircraft investigation duties both primary and secondary AICK will be secured within the brigade clinic.
6. The key for the AICK will be attached to the ammo box with a metal, serial numbered security band on the opposite side of the lock.
7. The contents of the AICK will be inventoried every six months (at the same time as the key control inspection). The contents will also be inventoried when the security band has been broken.
8. The AICK contains the following:
  - a. Engineer Tape (approx. 6" dia.)
  - b. 4 batteries in the package (D sz)
  - c. 12 batteries in the package (AA sz)
  - d. 1 pair safety glasses
  - e. 12 ball point pens
  - f. 12 mechanical pencils

- g. 12 grease pencils
- h. 1 compass
- i. 1 mirror
- j. 6 broad tip black markers
- k. 1 whistle
- l. 1 pair scissors
- m. 1 100' measuring tape
- n. 1 multi-tool
- o. 1 tape recorder
- p. 2 sixty minute tapes
- q. 1 magnifying glass
- r. 1 roll masking tape
- s. 1 wooden 12" ruler
- t. 50 marking flags
- u. 1 tablet of paper
- v. 1 tablet of graph paper
